Incentives

Each approved applicant will be eligible to receive a financial incentive that covers up to \$1,000 per course*. Associated costs, including but not limited to travel, food, lodging and test fees, are not eligible for incentives. The applicant must submit proof of attendance via a certificate of completion or other similar documentation in order to receive an incentive.

Applicants must apply for and receive preapproval from BGE before enrolling in a course. BGE has prequalified certain courses from specific training organizations, a list of which can be found at **BGESmartEnergy.com/BOT**. In addition, BGE will review all courses proposed by applicants and employers.
