

ESFB Form Change Summary 2011

ALL FORMS

New W-9 requirement has been added to all application forms.

Total incentive limits per Corporate tax ID per year for all incentives (prescriptive and custom) are limited to \$1,000,000.

INDIVIDUAL FORM CHANGES

Motors

The motor application form has been eliminated. This is due to the Energy Independence and Security Act (EISA) that became effective on December 19, 2010. The law effectively mandates that the premium efficiency motors currently incentivized through the program will become baseline code.

Unitary HVAC

Table 1 of the form now captures the different types of unit efficiency numbers (EER, SEER and IEER), given the code changes to ASHRAE 90.1 – 2007.

HVAC Chillers

The minimum efficiency requirements increased.

Variable Frequency Drives

Incentive levels have been reduced for VFDs ranging from 5-30 HP.

Commercial Kitchens

No change for 2011.

Commercial Refrigeration

No change for 2011 with the exception of removing the LED case lighting measure since a standalone LED application from has been developed.

Custom

Additional project type created to include selections for Comprehensive Design Track projects.

Prescriptive Lighting

1. Eliminated the following measures:
 - a. Measure Code 30
 - b. Measure Code 84
 - c. Measure Code 88
 - d. Measure Code 95
2. Revised the current incentive levels or technical requirements for the following measures:
 - a. Measure Code 25
 - b. Measure Code 60 – now captured in Measure Codes 61-63
 - c. Measure Code 86
 - d. Measure Code 90

New Construction Performance Lighting

1. Increased Tier 1 minimum requirements from >10% below base LPV to >15% below base LPD; keeping incentive amount intact.
2. Increased Tier 2 minimum requirements from >20% below base LPD to >30% below base LPD; keeping incentive amount intact.
3. Added a new construction controls table.
4. Updated eligibility requirements to reflect the use of ASHRAE/IESNA 90.1 - 2007.
5. General Updates:
 - a. Project submittals must now contain COMCHECK or equivalent reports to substantiate LPD claims.
 - b. Updated the ASHRAE version in Section VI to ASHRAE/IESNA 90.1 - 2007.

Prescriptive LED

A prescriptive LED application form has been created for a limited number of common LED measures.

OTHER 2011 CHANGES

Lighting System Rated Wattage List

Updated to reflect necessary changes associated with changes listed above.

Prescriptive Lighting Worksheet and New Construction Lighting Worksheet

Updated to reflect necessary changes associated with changes listed above.

ROLL OUT TIMELINE

The new 2011 application forms are effective Monday April 25, 2011.

The previous forms will no longer be accepted after Friday, May 13, 2011.

All previously “pre approved” applications will remain as approved. No adjustments will be made to reflect changes.

All application forms submitted after April 1, 2011 and not pre approved as of Friday, May 13, 2011 will be evaluated on the new program guidelines.
